3. Read Matthew 21:22; Hebrews 11:1 and James 1:6-7. What does it mean to pray in faith? What are some things that you have said while praying that reveal a lack of faith?
4. Read John 9:31. These words were spoken by Jesus' opponents. Do you think they are true? Why or why not? If they are true, what does it say about the effectiveness of your prayer life?
5. Read 1 John 5:16-17. What might the "sin that leads to death" be? How do you need to personally apply these verses to your life?
