2. How many verses can you find in the Bible that say explicitly that God will not judge Christians? How many can you find that say He will?

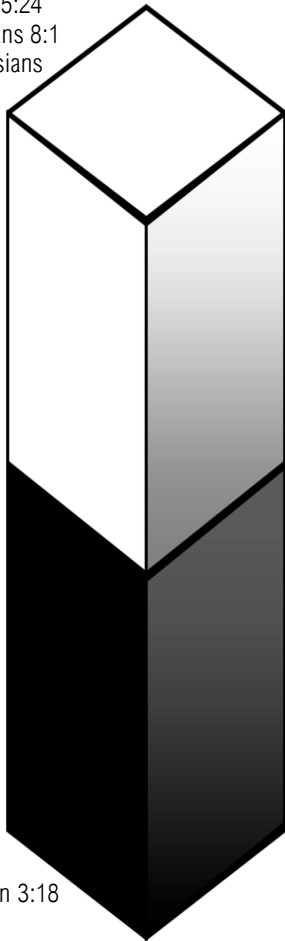
3. How do you harmonize John 5:24 and John 5:28-29?
