2. Read Matthew 15:7 and Matthew 7:1-5. Why do you think we are more likely to write harsh things online than we are to say harsh things to others face-to-face?
3. Read Ephesians 4:29. How does this passage apply to what you text and type on digital devices?
4. Read Matthew 25:31-46 and Luke 25:31-46. How can you make sure that your phone does not make you “blind” to the needs of those in close physical proximity to you?
5. Besides the ways in which your phone helps or hinders you in your goal of loving God and loving others, what positive or negative effects does your phone have on your spiritual life?
