1. What is the most frustrating dead end in your life right now? How have you tried to

get out of it?

2.	Read Psalm 46:10 and Isaiah 43:7. How do you think God wants to magnify Himself in the midst of your biggest trial right now? If He chooses not to do the impossible, what will it take for you to endure the unimaginable?
3.	Read Philippians 2:3-5. Who are some of the people you have met or gotten to know better because of a dead end in your life? How do you think God wants you to enrich their lives?
4.	Read John 17:3 and Philippians 3:8. Have obstacles and delays in your life brought you closer to God or pushed you further from Him? How close are you to Him right now?
5.	Read Romans 8:28-29. How has God used past trials to make you more like Jesus? How might He be using present trials to accomplish that goal?
6.	Read James 1:5-6. What has God revealed to you about His purpose(s) for the biggest dead end or detour in your life?
