3. Re-read 1 Corinthians 14:1-19. Based on these verses, do you think it is ever proper to use a gift for self-edification? If so, when? If not, why not?
4. What is wrong with attending church primarily to have your needs met? Do you think White Pine would better meet your needs if everyone (including you) came to give instead of to get? Why or why not?
5. Look again at Paul's description of a church meeting in 1 Corinthians 14:26. In what setting do you think it would be most appropriate for someone to exercise a gift like prophecy or tongues?
6. What lingering questions do you still have about spiritual gifts?
