Questions for Reflection and Discussion

1. Do you think God has ever spoken to you? If so, what did He say?
2. Who are some biblical characters that the Lord spoke to? Do you think we should expect God to speak to us like He spoke to them? Why or why not?
3. Who are some biblical characters that the Lord did not speak to—either for a long time or in their whole lifetime? What can we learn from their behavior during periods of divine silence?
4. What are some of the different ways God spoke to people in the Bible? (Here are some passage to help you make a list: Genesis 15:1; 1 Kings 19:11-13; 2 Kings 20:1-6; Matthew 1:20; Acts 8:26.) What can you learn from the different ways God spoke to people in the Bible?
5. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. Does God speak to you through the Bible? Has there ever been a time when He spoke to you in a very personal way through a specific passage?
6. What questions did this week's message raise in your mind? How can you find answers to those questions?
