3. Read Joel 1:15; 2:2; 2:11; 2:13 and 2:31. Do you believe you will suffer God’s wrath? Why or why not?
4. Read Acts 2:23. Do you think you are in any way responsible for the crucifixion of Christ? If someone was to say to you, “You nailed Jesus to the cross!”, how would you respond?
5. Read Joel 2:12, Acts 2:38, and James 4:9. How do these verses add to your understanding of repentance?
6. Do you believe that baptism is an option for Christians? What passages of Scripture shape your view? (If you want to dig a little deeper, read these passages in the book of Acts: 3:19; 8:12-13; 8:35-38; 10:43-48; 13:38-39; 16:14-15; 16:30-34; 19:4-5; 22:16.)
