Questions for Reflection and Discussion

1. Read Hebrews 11:6. Do you think expectant faith makes it easier to find God? If so, why? How would you respond to the charge that faith makes you see what isn't really there?
2. Read Psalm 27:4-8. What is the one thing you are most passionate about? Do you think your passion for God—or the lack of it—affects your ability to find Him? Give yourself a passion grade (A-F).
3. Read Matthew 5:8 and John 14:21. Is there any area of disobedience or impurity in your life that is making intimacy with God impossible? If so, what is keeping you from repenting?
4. Read Job 13:24 and Job 27:2-6. In the midst of Job's suffering, what did He do wrong? What did He do right? How are you like/unlike Job?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 11:2, Ephesians 5:31-32 and Revelation 19:7-9. In what sense is our present relationship with Christ like being engaged? When will we be "married" to Jesus, and how will that change our relationship with Him?
