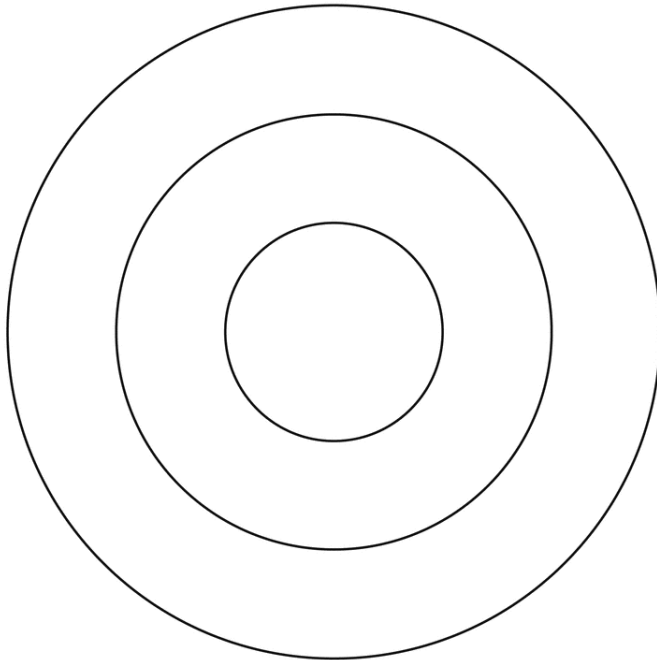


RECALCULATING

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Read Mark 3:7-19. Who can you relate to the most in this passage: the helpless crowd, the hesitant disciples or the ambitious Jesus? In what way do you feel helpless, hesitant or ambitious right now?
2. Does any area of your life feel "unfixable"? Where will you end up if nothing changes? How might your future be different if you relentlessly pursue Jesus for help?
3. Do you sense that Jesus is calling you to up your commitment to Him in any way? Are you all in or hesitant? Why? How do you think your life might look different 10 years from now if you say "yes"? And if you say "no"?
4. Why do you think Jesus spent so much time with so few people? Do you think you are supposed to follow His example? Why or why not? How could you begin to seek your own "disciples"?
5. In your spiritual life, what must change if you do not want to end up where you are heading?
