QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION

1. Would you consider yourself a seeker or a believer? If you are a seeker, what evidence is there in your life that you are sincerely searching for spiritual truth? If you are a believer, would you consider yourself a willing witness? Why or why not?

2. Read Proverbs 16:9; 19:21; 20:24. How would you paraphrase the teaching of these three passages? What practical implications does this truth have for your life?

3. Read Acts 8:26, 29; 10:19; 11:12; 13:2-4; 16:6-7; 20:22-23. What are some of the ways that the Holy Spirit has “spoken” to you? When has something special happened because you obeyed His prompting?

4. If somebody were to ask you how to become a Christian, what passages of Scripture would you use to explain the gospel to them? How would you tell them to express their faith in Christ?

5. Which of the principles from Sunday’s message was most challenging to you personally? What changes do you need to make to apply this principle to your daily life?

6. What other issues or questions did Acts 8:26-40 raise for you?
