Questions for Reflection & Discussion

2. Read Isaiah 53:4, Matthew 8:17, John 20:30 and John 21:25. Do you think the healing ministry of Jesus was abnormal or the new normal? Why?
3. Read Luke 9:1-2, Luke 10:1, John 14:12-14 and 1 Corinthians 12:7-9. What do these passages tell us about God's plan for supernatural healing between the first and second comings of Jesus?
4. Read James 5:14-16. Why do you think we are hesitant to follow these instructions? If you have ever done what this passage encourages, what were the results?
5. Read Revelation 21:4 and Revelation 22:2. Do you think that when God allows someone whose healing you pray for to die, He is answering your prayers or not?
